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PRODUCTION INFORMATION

<u>Health and Safety Policy</u> —Temperatures will be taken and hand sanitizer given to dancers, Dancenter staff, and volunteers upon entering backstage. Hand sanitizer will also be available throughout the venue. Everyone will be required to wear a mask in the venue (on and off stage). We will be providing dancers with disposable masks and decorative mask covers to wear for the performances. Audience members should bring their own masks to wear. Stephens Auditorium requires face masks of all audience members.

Drop Off /Backstage Policy — DO NOT park in the loading zone! Only dancers, staff, and volunteers will be allowed backstage. Dancers enter Stephens through the stage door on the southeast side of the building. Parents of Candy Cane Cuties and Reindeer Round-up dancers may come backstage to take their dancer to their dressing room and get them in costume, and then must go out to the auditorium. Dancers' temperatures will be taken upon entry and they will given hand sanitizer, so please be sure to stop at the backstage table. Parents are allowed backstage after the show, to pick up their dancer.

<u>Videotaping</u> — Parents may videotape and/or take photos at rehearsals only. Dancers will be in costume during these rehearsals. PHOTO ACTIVITY MAY NOT INTERFERE WITH REHEARSALS.

<u>DVDs</u> – DVDs of each performance will be available for purchase. Please inquire at the Dancenter or backstage at Stephens Auditorium.

Volunteers — We are asking the families of cast members to provide volunteer help in lieu of supplemental participant fees. This additional help will keep our performances running smoothly and safely. A sign-up sheet is available online. An email was sent with the link you will need to use. There are specific assignments for each of the performances.

<u>Misc. Information/Take Note</u> — Please leave all jewelry and other accessories that are not part of the *Sugarplum Celebration* performances at home. Also, there is to be no fingernail polish on your nails.

<u>Gifting Table</u> — In an effort to minimize groups of dancers congregating, there will not be a gifting table. If you choose to give gifts, please do so before arriving at Stephens Auditorium.

<u>Only Authorized Persons Backstage</u> – Only badge-holding authorized persons (staff and volunteers) are allowed backstage.

HAIR

-NO BANGS ALLOWED FOR ANY FEMALE DANCERS
ALL FEMALE DANCERS SHOULD WEAR THEIR HAIR IN THE "JOFFREY DO"
AS DESCRIBED & ILLUSTRATED BELOW:

The back of the lady's hair is put in a ponytail high on the back of the head. Not in the middle of the back of the head which is not a good line up from the neck. The front of her hair about 3-4 inches from the forehead is not in the ponytail and needs to be parted in the middle. One side of the hair is curved along the face line, pulled back above the ear, pinned down with bobby pins above the ears and back to the ponytail. Then the hair is wrapped around the ponytail and pinned to secure. Then do the same with the other side. Both sides should be very smooth to the head, not puffy. Then wrap the ponytail hair around in a bun like usual, secure with a hair net and then of course a lot of hairpins, not bobby pins. They are too small. All this needs to have hair spray during the process to keep the hair smooth to the head. Also, the hair under the bun needs to have a lot of hair spray and pins to keep it tight and smooth to the head. Vaseline in the hair under the bun will help keep wispies and fly-away hairs in place. For this hairdo to come out well the dancers need to do it quite a few times for them to master it, but also for the hair itself to get used to going a different way. It is very important that it is very smooth and that the hair framing the face has a very sharp curved line. And finally, again, that the bun is high.



-Please wear HAIRNETS over all buns. Please attempt to make bobby pins/hair pins as invisible as possible. (For example, use pins that match hair color.)

-Please bring your own combs, hairnets, hairspray and any other supplies needed to maintain your hair.

PLEASE DO HAIR AT HOME BEFORE COMING TO THE THEATRE!

-BOYS/MEN: neatly trimmed, preferably off the ears and collar and out of the eyes.

COSTUMES

All costumes and costume pieces should be hung in the dressing rooms after the dress rehearsal and between performances. No costumes/pieces should leave Stephens until after the last performance. Rental Costumes should be turned in at Stephens following the 6pm performance. All dancers are responsible for all pieces and the condition of their costumes. Any lost pieces or damage to the rental costumes from negligence will be billed to you. NO EATING OR DRINKING while in costume (not even water)! Gauge your dressing time so you are not in costume for long periods before your entrance. Keep costumes on hangers and keep all pieces together. Please keep all tags pinned to the rental costumes even during performances, and be sure to tuck tags in so they cannot be seen when costume is worn onstage. Wash hands thoroughly after applying make-up, before touching costumes!!


MAKEUP


All dancers will wear the standard that we have for our Expos—brown eyebrow pencil (or darker, if needed to match the individual dancer's eyebrow color) and black eyeliner, NO EYE SHADOW, SPARKLY BODY POWDER, OR SPARKLY HAIRSPRAY. As all dancers will be wearing face masks, blush and lipstick are unnecessary.

PLEASE DO MAKEUP AT HOME BEFORE COMING TO THE THEATER.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKE-UP Make-up should be darker than street make-up

- 1. EYEBROWS · Imagine a line extending from the widest edge of your note to the corner of your eye up-ward · this is where your eyebrow should stop. Use your eyebrow pencil to apply feather strokes in the upward and outward direction that the hair grows. Then use a eyebrow brush, a soft child's toothbrush, or a Q-tip to soften and blend the strokes in with the real hair.
- 2. EYELINER . On the top Bd right above your lashes draw a line from the inside corner where your lashes start to 1/4" past the outside corner of the eye. Look forward and under the lower lashes draw a line from the center of your pupil to the outside of the corner of the eye connecting the two lines.
