## **Details:**

- Registration begins at 11:15 a.m.
- Parking is available in Lots A3, B1 & B2 (south, north & east sides of Stephens Auditorium).
- Enter Stephens Auditorium at the Southeast Corner.
- DO NOT drop off or park in the loading dock area.
- Dancers need to be dressed, warmed-up and ready to audition at the times listed below.
- All dancers should wear leotards, tights, and ballet or pointe shoes.
- Dancers MUST be enrolled in a dance studio and pointe dancers MUST be studying pointe to perform.
- Children must be 6 years of age or older to perform.
- You may be cast in a part for which you did not audition. We reserve the right to cast you in ANY part.
- Dancers are encouraged to audition for every role they are capable of performing.
- Casting notices will be emailed no later than September 1, 2025.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION for 2025:**

- Carefully review the 2025 Nutcracker Rehearsal Schedule (see page 2) and note potential conflicts.
- You MUST attend the first rehearsal for your role. <u>NEW THIS YEAR</u>: Dancers will not add conflicts on audition card. Everyone is allowed up to two absences per role. If you miss the first rehearsal, or miss more than two rehearsals for a role, we reserve the right to replace you.
- First rehearsal will be at the Ames Dancenter South, 319 South 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Ames, IA 50010.
- Call the Dancenter, home of the Iowa Youth Ballet, at (515) 233-0826 with any questions.
- There is a \$75 participation fee per performer (additional dancers in same household are \$60 each). This fee covers one costume cleaning fee. Any additional costumes will be charged a \$25 costume cleaning fee per piece. A \$10 late fee per registration and/or costume cleaning fee will be added after 10/3/25.
- YOUR HELP IS NEEDED A Volunteer Coordinator will contact all participating families for backstage help at
  rehearsals and performances. Families of each cast member are required to provide volunteer help in lieu of
  supplemental participant fees. This helps keep costs down & keeps our performances running smoothly & safely.
